 - Potential roles of IRDR: priorities 6 (regional science), 9 (collaboration), 5 (technology), and 2 (inequality and vulnerability)

Item 6: A Framework for Global Science in support of risk-informed SD and PH, pre-publication stage,

- Strong support to the document, to move forward to coordinated implementation of the framework, **action plan** (prioritisation of the priorities, who are doing what within IRDR, funding, connecting/complementarities with other global science frameworks/programs), socialisation/sensitisation to other organisations
- **How:** ownership of the framework, meeting to discuss, IRDR to connect back to others involved, champion, organic development of the network, focus on regional implementation, lessons from 2010-2020 implementation,
- **UNDRR:** follow up actions? UNDRR may support

Item 6: **Future of IRDR/next phase of IRDR**

Based on: IRDR Science Plan 2010-2020, IRDR Compilation of 201—2020: A decade of science of DRR, IRDR communities and capacities

Questions: timeline including other key events, structures /governance, partnership, roles of youth, prioritisation of research priorities, IRDR to coordinate particular implementation of research priority, mapping on partnerships (private sector, indigenous communities, non-traditional stakeholders, map the publications/materials by members, stronger roles of regional and national committees, *ownership*

Potential roles: (1) As international think-tank, research, foresight studies, advocacy, dialogue, (2) As international workplace for standard and agenda setting in risk science and policy, (3) As hub
